

BRANIFF BOARD TOUR AT 7701 TODAY CELEBRATES 60TH ANNIVERSARY - A fantastic time was enjoyed today during the Braniff Board Member site tour of the Braniff International Operations and Maintenance Base at Dallas Love Field. The base is currently undergoing a complete restoration and remodeling process and should be open sometime in 2019.

The Truman Arnold Companies, which will be one of the largest tenants in the building, graciously arranged the tour for the group.
